FR. DAN IS THE PROUD RECIPIENT OF THE 2023 RICHARD J. DALEY POLICE MEDAL OF HONOR FOR A LIFE-SAVING ENDEAVOR FOLLOWING A ROLL-OVER ACCIDENT HE WITNESSED ON THE KENNEDY EXPRESSWAY.

HE ALSO SERVED AS THE GRAND MARSHAL OF THE 2023 SOUTH SIDE IRISH PARADE, SAID TO BE THE LARGEST ST. PATRICK'S DAY PARADE OUTSIDE DUBLIN. BEING AN AMERICAN AND IRISH DUAL CITIZEN, HE IS PARTICULARLY PROUD OF THIS HONOR.
